CA meeting August 29, 2015 in Milan, Italy.

**Decisions:**

- New Members approved: (See list attached)
- Daniela Nicodemo was approved as webmaster. It was decided to make an official website with a 'members only' section. Sadegh might help to establish the website. Deadline: December 22th.
- Patrick Fontan was approved as Head of the Databank. Noriko asked for a questionnaire to describe the samples that are sent to the database. Patrick asked all members to send him information if they

have material they would give to the database. All material will be anonymous. Material will only be used if the owner of the material gives permission.

- Logo for CSIRA-ARISI. Proposals should be sent to Anne. Deadline September 30.
- Japanese society for the CS website and CSIRA-ARISI website share links in order to show they are good sisters.
- Congress 2017, brainstorm. CSIRA/ARISI is an official partner to the ISR (International Society of the Rorschach and Projective Methods) for the organization of the 2017 congress. We therefore must decide the best way to show our presence. Also, it is necessary to confront R-PAS and it might be an ideal platform to do so. Patrick would present a critical analysis of the “scientific” basis of the R-PAS (3 points: The “problem of R”, the “international” reference data and cross-cultural issues). CSIRA-ARISI will also arrange a symposium inside the ISR congress, rather than holding a parallel congress.
- Rorschach Archives. Delegates are asked to send articles from their own country to the International Archives. Books and reprints are to be sent to the library in Bern
